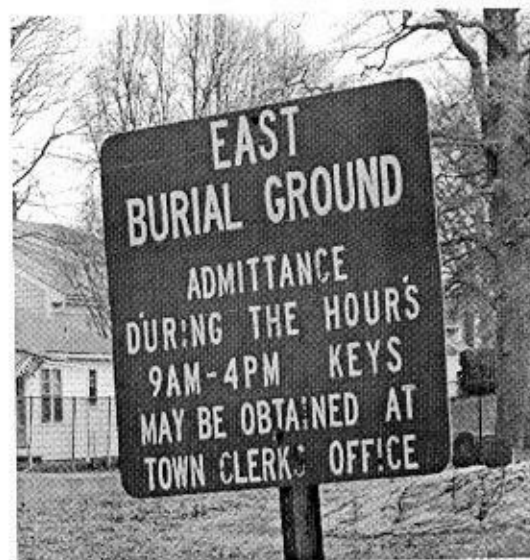

## Newport County

### “Baptist Berkleys White Hall farm” / The Hubbard Lot, Middletown, RI (MT056)

The Hubbard lot is in the vicinity of the Whitehall Museum House, located at 311 Berkeley Ave., Middletown, RI. (401) 846-3116. (<http://whitehallmuseumhouse.org> info@whitehallmuseumhouse.org ) Dean Berkeley had Whitehall built in 1729, to provide a residence for himself and his new family during their sojourn in Rhode Island until 1731. Since 1900, the building has been maintained by the National Society of the Colonial Dames in the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations (founded 1890), who have opened it to the public every summer.

"Hubbard Lot: Samuel Hubbard Death 1639. Foot Stone ... Location: Located on Bishop Berkley/ White Hall Farm Actual site not located... This sole surviving stone and foot stone are all that remains of a small family cemetery. It was found near the door step of White Hall in the flower bed. "the original cemetery was dismantled by Collector Robinson about 1765 after he bought the lease on the property. All of the original grave stones were placed into the rock wall. The remainder of the stones are most likely still retained in one of the many rock walls on the property. This stone and the accompanying foot stone are now located at Paradise School. Headquarters of Middletown's Historical Society. This very archaic inscription was hand etched into a common field stone Although it is colonial style English, enough of it can be transcribed to enable us to conclude that it is the marker for the grave of Samuel Hubbard. According to existing records he was born about 1610 in Mendelsham, Suffolk Co., England and died in Newport R.I. about 1689. There is little doubt that his wife and many other descendants are also buried on the property of White Hall. "The literary Diary of Ezra Stiles Vol. III" contains an inscription of a singular stone which he transcribed himself in 1763 prior to the cemetery's destruction. "the literary Diary of Ezra Stiles Vol., III"

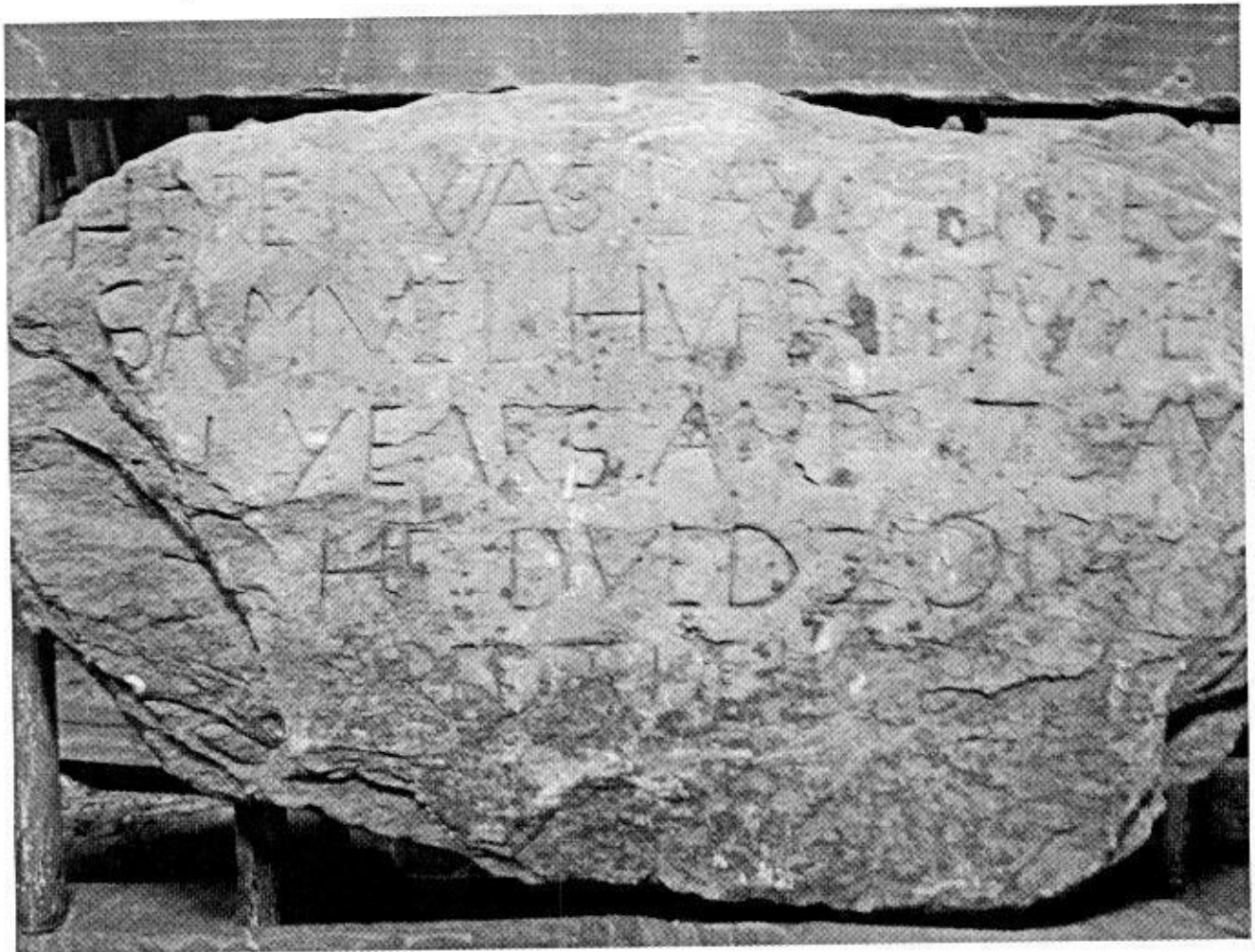

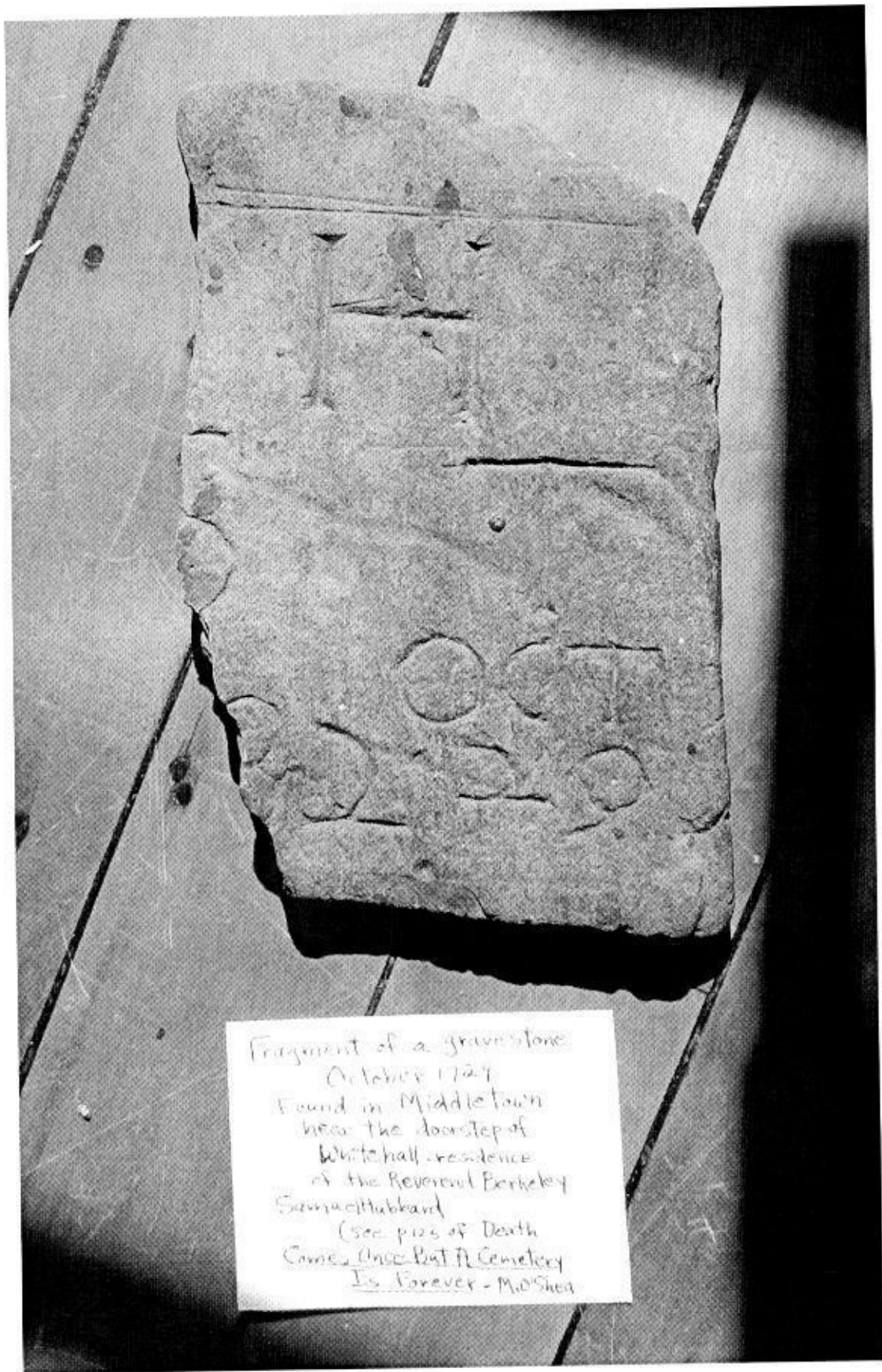

"I took this inscription off a gravestone in a family burying place on Baptist Berkleys White Hall farm on Rh. Isld, about A. D. 1763. Collector Robinson bought the Lease about 1765 and demolished the gravestones and put them into a wall: so that all is lost. From a loose paper which I, wrote in 1763 I now copy here. This Samuel Hubbard was a Baptist Teacher, settled at Newport about 1648 and made this Eben. 1688. Intricate as it seems, more is contained on this stone than can be given in other words in so small a space. I think 1688 must be a year common to Four dates. I should suppose the stone erected Sep 27, 1688, when the wife was aged 79 and 7 mo., and Mr. Hubbard was aged 78 on May 10 that year and on 4 Jany they had been married 51 years. The 14 Vpsal 4 is the 145th Psalm and the 4th verse---'One generation shall praise thy works to another.' The B and C, I think a beautiful way of expressing lineal Descents. Thus Naomi B Rogers, I take to be Naomi Burdick who married Rogers---so Judah C Maxson was the Daughter of Bethiah Clark and it will be read Judah Clark Maxson."

I received an email from the Middletown, RI Historical Society on August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2010 saying "Hi, I am sending 2 pics taken a few years ago. They are stored in the basement at Paradise School and were taken from the Hubbard Cemetery --actually, as I recall they were found in one of the stone walls around the property at Whitehall Farm. ## Chimney Orchard, Hopkinton, RI

Chimney Orchard is mentioned in a few books but there is no actual historical record known about its existence. Some consider it a family myth but I suspect that the Wells Lot (HP025) is actually Chimney Orchard. I have no proof of this, it is only my own supposition.

"Thomas, son of Nathaniel WELLS, was born in Colchester, England, in 1626. He came with his parents to America in 1629. He was a shipwright and carpenter. From 1648 to 1651 he was in New London, Connecticut, where he had a grant of land in 1649. He removed from there to Ipswich where he was engaged in shipbuilding until 1677, at about which date he removed to Rhode Island and lived in Wellstown. He is mentioned at Westerly in 1677 as engaged in building vessels in a shipyard, and is called "of Ipswich, shipwright". He bought a farm of one hundred and eighty acres in Westerly, Rhode Island, on the east side of Pawcatuck river, now Westerly. For this farm Wells agreed to build a small vessel for Amos Richardson, but he soon found that the land was claimed by Rhode Island and as he was afraid of losing the land he refused to build the ship. Richardson sued in the lower court and it was carried to the court of assistants at Hartford, where it lasted until 1680. Two of Thomas Well's sons, Joseph H., aged twenty-two, and Thomas, aged seventeen, appeared as witnesses in this lawsuit. Rhode Island won the suit and Wells procured the land by paying Rhode Island. He died February 12, 1700, aged seventy-four, at his home in Wellstown, located in that portion of the township of Westerly which afterward became the township of Hopkinton, and was buried in the burial place Chimney Orchard, on the estate first purchased by his father. He took the oath of fidelity to the colony at Westerly, September 17, 1679."

"On the Westerly Records is a deed dated 1694, signed by Thomas Welles and Sarah his wife, giving to his brothers Nathaniel and John, a piece of land which was left him by his father, and which lay near a place called Crandall's Mills, in westerly Township. There is also his will recorded at same place, dated April 11, 1716 (W. Rec., vol 1, p. 166 (might be 126 or 186, hard to read)), and proved in 1716, in which, after providing for his widow Sarah, he gives his property to his children, Thomas, Edward and Sarah, and wishes his brother Nathaniel and John Maxson to assist them in the settlement. He mentions about the "Chimney Orchard," which is still known as the burial place of the family"

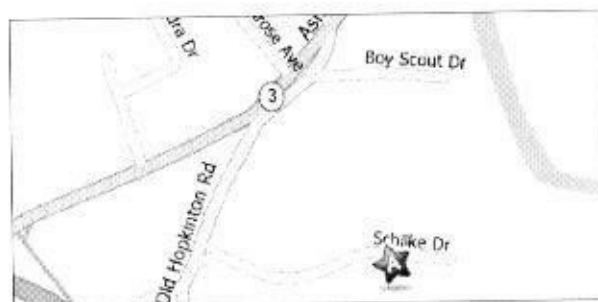
Cemetery is located 100 Feet South of Schilke Drive, at Telephone Pole #5942 and contains 40 burials with 10 inscriptions  
NOTE: Rev. Frederic Denison recorded this lot in 1867-8: "This burying place is situated in the northern portion of the town on the estate of Weeden Clark Esq, about twenty rods northwest of Mr. C's residence, in a meadow and is without enclosure. Here are numerous graves, only a part of which have inscribed stones."

Frederic Demison recorded this lot in 1867-8: This ancient burial ground is on the bank of the Pawcatuck, on its curve, above the "Meeting-house Bridge," and a few rods east of the "Pound Road," "unenclosed, in the edge of a grove, and sadly overgrown with bushes.

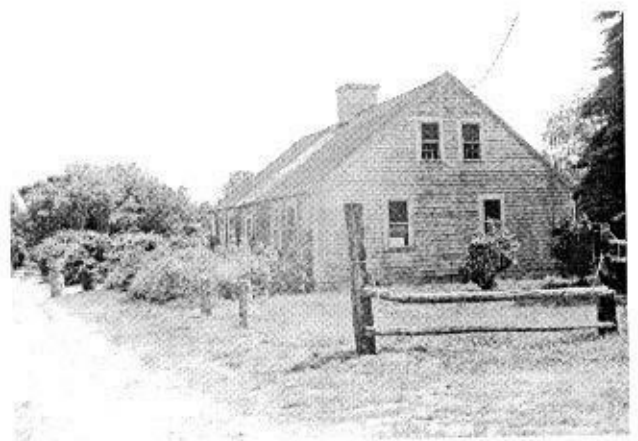
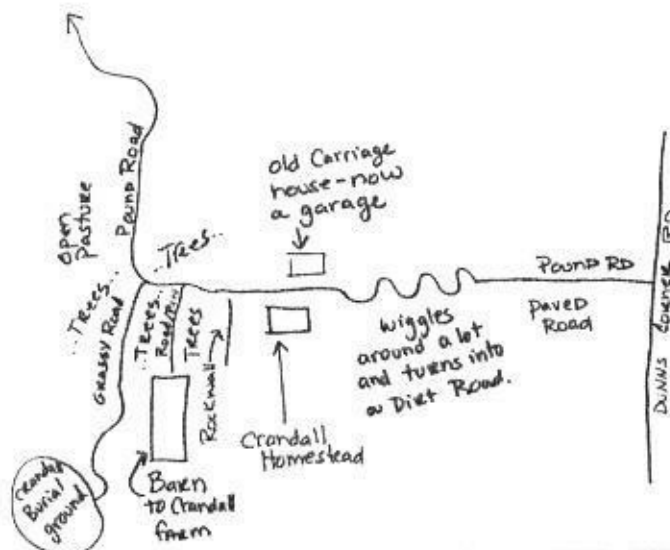

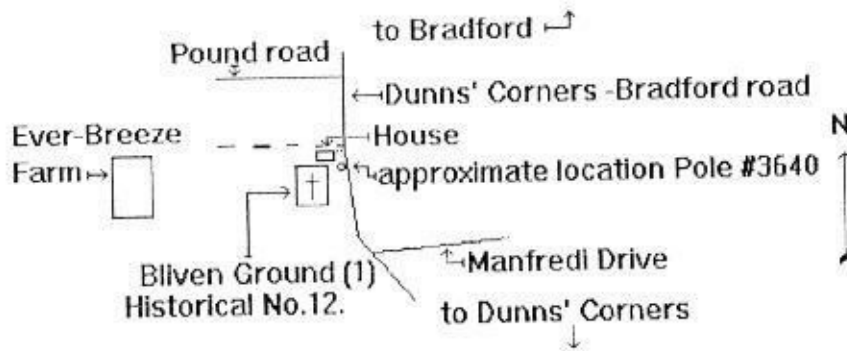

Hope Valley Advertiser, Thursday February 7, 1907 ... Death of Silas C. Wells - An aged resident of Ashaway ... "Silas C. Wells of Ashaway died in that village last Saturday morning in his 94th year. He was the eldest son of Russell and Lydia (Crandall) Wells and was born 15 November 1813. Although his brothers and sisters attained mature years, he outlived them all. He was twice married, both his wives dying before him. Of the five children born to him, three survive. Mrs. A.A. Palmiter of Westerly, Mrs. John S. Burdick, with whom he has lived with for a number of years and Wallace R. Wells, also of Ashaway. The deceased was ever industrious and for many years followed farming and the dressing of calves and poultry mainly for the Boston Market. He was an early advocate of political prohibition and was a consistent member of the party. He was the oldest or one of the oldest living members of the Seventh Day Baptist Church in Ashaway and in his old age one of its most regular attendants. About five years ago, a picture was taken in Ashaway of a group of eight old men whose ages clustered about 90 years. The death of Mr. Wells now leaves Deacon Matthew Kenyon the oldest of the group, the only survivor at the age of nearly 96 years. These two old men have for years been neighbors living across the street from each other. Mr. Wells retained his faculties to the last and enjoyed the visits of his neighbors. Although confined to bed for several months, he apparently suffered little pain and the end came like one falling asleep.

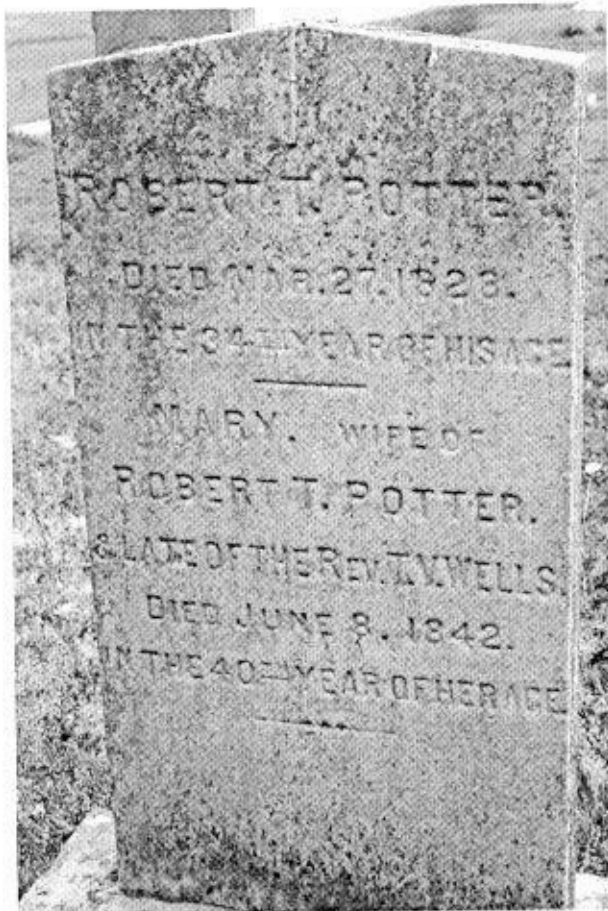

I., died on Monday evening, Dec. 19th, at the residence of her son-in-law, Mr. Henry Whipple, in Westerly, aged 90 years, 4 months and 10 days. She was a daughter of the Senior Mr. George Potter, of Potter Hill, and among her sisters and brothers, all of whom preceded her to the grave, were Mrs. Nancy Maxson, (RIVER BEND CEMETERY) wife of the late Jonathan Maxson, of Westerly; Mrs. Mary Rogers, (WEST NECK CEMETERY) wife of the late Dea. David Rogers, of Waterford, Conn.; Mrs. Sally Fenner Irish, wife of the late Mr. George Irish, of Hopkinton; Dea. George Potter, of Little Genesee, N. Y.; Mr. Charles Potter, of Adams Centre, N. Y., and Mr. Benjamin Potter, of Hopkinton. When a girl of some seventeen years, she made a profession of religion and joined the First Seventh day Baptist church, in Hopkinton, from which church her membership was transferred at the time of the organization of the Second Hopkinton Church, of which she became a constituent member. When about twenty years of age she was married to Mr. Joseph Spicer, of Hopkinton City, with whom she lived nearly sixty years, until his death in 1876; since which time she has been always a welcome member or visitor in the families of her children. Her only daughter who attained mature years, was the late Mrs. Mary Whipple, of Westerly, who died some four years ago. Another of her children, Mr. William Spicer, of West Hallock, Ill., died some six years ago. Her children now living are Charles and Albert H. Spicer, of Westerly, George H. Spicer, of Hopkinton City, Edward D. Spicer, of Adams, N. Y., Noyes Spicer, of Brooklyn, N. Y., J. Denison Spicer, of Plainfield, N. J., and John G. Spicer, of West Hallock, Ill. She also left surviving her 23 grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren, and 4 great-great-grandchildren. Mrs. Spicer filled worthily, for a long period, an important place in a family widely known and greatly respected in Rhode Island, and in other states as well. It may properly be said of her, that she died of old age. She had known very little of actual sickness. Early in the morning of her last day on earth, she had some difficulty about breathing, which was soon relieved, and she passed the day quite comfortably in her usual avocation of knitting. 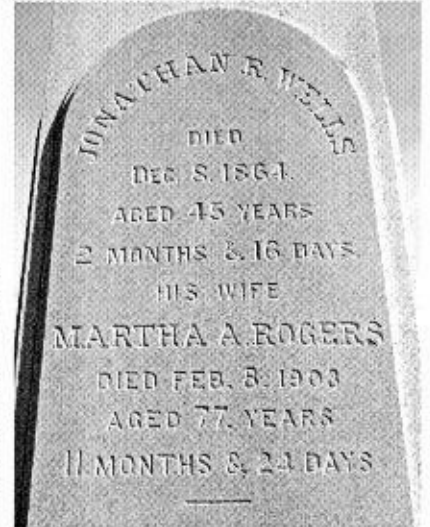

I., April 2, 1893, of apoplexy, Charles Spicer, in the 72d year of his age. Mr. Spicer was born in the town of Hopkinton, R. I., Aug. 6, 1821. He was the son of Joseph and Content Potter Spicer, being the oldest but one of eleven children. He lived in Hopkinton until 1858, when he removed to Westerly, where he lived till the time of his death. Oct. 30, 1841, he married Sarah Ann Davis, of Hopkinton, who bore him four children. At an early age he gave his heart to Christ and united with the Second Hopkinton Seventh-day Baptist Church, of which he remained a member till 1864, when he became a member of the Pawcatuck Seventh-day Baptist Church, of which he was a member at his death. For a number of years he was a teacher in the Sabbath-school and was always a devoted and loyal member of the church. As a Christian he was ever conscientious, charitable and peace-loving. His faith was calm and serene. Seldom was there a man so esteemed by all who knew him. Mr. Spicer leaves six surviving brothers, a wife, and three daughters. "Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright; for the end of that man is peace." Funeral services were held at his late residence in Westerly, R. I. April 5, 1893, conducted by his pastor. The sister, who was the wife of George H. Spicer, of Hopkinton, died a few years ago. She was married at Hopkinton October 30, 1841, to Charles Spicer. To them were born four children, Mrs. Henry Chester, of Ashaway; Mrs. Henry G. Pierce, of Rehoboth, Mass., and Mrs. George F. Clark, of Westerly, and Henry Spicer, who died in 1876. Mrs. Spicer confessed her faith in the Lord Jesus Christ early in life and united with the First Hopkinton Seventh-day Baptist Church. In 1864 she joined the Pawcatuck Seventh-day Baptist Church in Westerly, and retained her membership in that body until death. She was a regular attendant on the services of the church as long as she was able, and had been a member of the Ladies' Benevolent Society. She was a lover of the Word of God and always had the book handy to read. She took great comfort in the sacred promises of the Lord. Since the death of her husband in 1893, Mrs. Spicer had spent her time, at will, with her daughters, Mrs. Clark and Mrs. Pierce. She had spent several months with Mrs. Pierce at Rehoboth, coming back last spring to Westerly. But the life of three score and ten with fifteen years added had continued until the body was not able to bear the burden of the years longer. It was simply a natural dissolution of the physical, without a weakening of the mental or any abating of the spiritual power, that brought death.
